Dear Parent / Carers

I am writing to you with an update to the confirmed COVID-19 case in year 9. Today we have completed our track and trace and some students will be asked to stay at home and isolate for 14 days. This is the advice given by Public Health England. Other household members **do not need to isolate**.

The reason that some students have to isolate for 14 days is because they have been identified as being in close contact. Close contact is within a metre for one minute or within two metres for 15 minutes.

Those who have to isolate for 14 days will be contacted and informed. We will also inform the meals company and you will be emailed a free school meal voucher if your child receives free school meals.

The rest of the year group can return to school on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> November at the normal time. The reason is that we have to carry out a deep clean of the classroom areas.

I very much appreciate the inconvenience of your child not being in school and the disruption to their learning. In the days your child is not in school they should be following their lessons via Google Classroom.
