We hope to bring you and your child some very **exciting transition opportunities** this term and are already working with colleagues in **Primary Schools** to ensure we provide amazing home learning activities to support their move to Langdon Park. There is a **video message** from myself in the Welcome to Year 7 page on our website for the students to view.

We are going to use Google to provide you with the **essential information forms** to gather information on your child which will be **emailed** in the following weeks and must be returned. Details of how to do this will be **included with the email**. If you

It is essential that we have copies of your child's full birth certificate that states parent's names, child's passports and a household bill with proof of address. Photographs of these documents sent in to the transition email address will be acceptable stating the full name of your child. During this time the school is open and you can come to the Byron Street reception from 9.00am — 11.00am Monday to Friday where either myself or a member of the senior leadership team is present to answer any questions and offer support and guidance.

We look forward to hearing from you very soon and please do check your email and our website regularly for further updates and information.
