

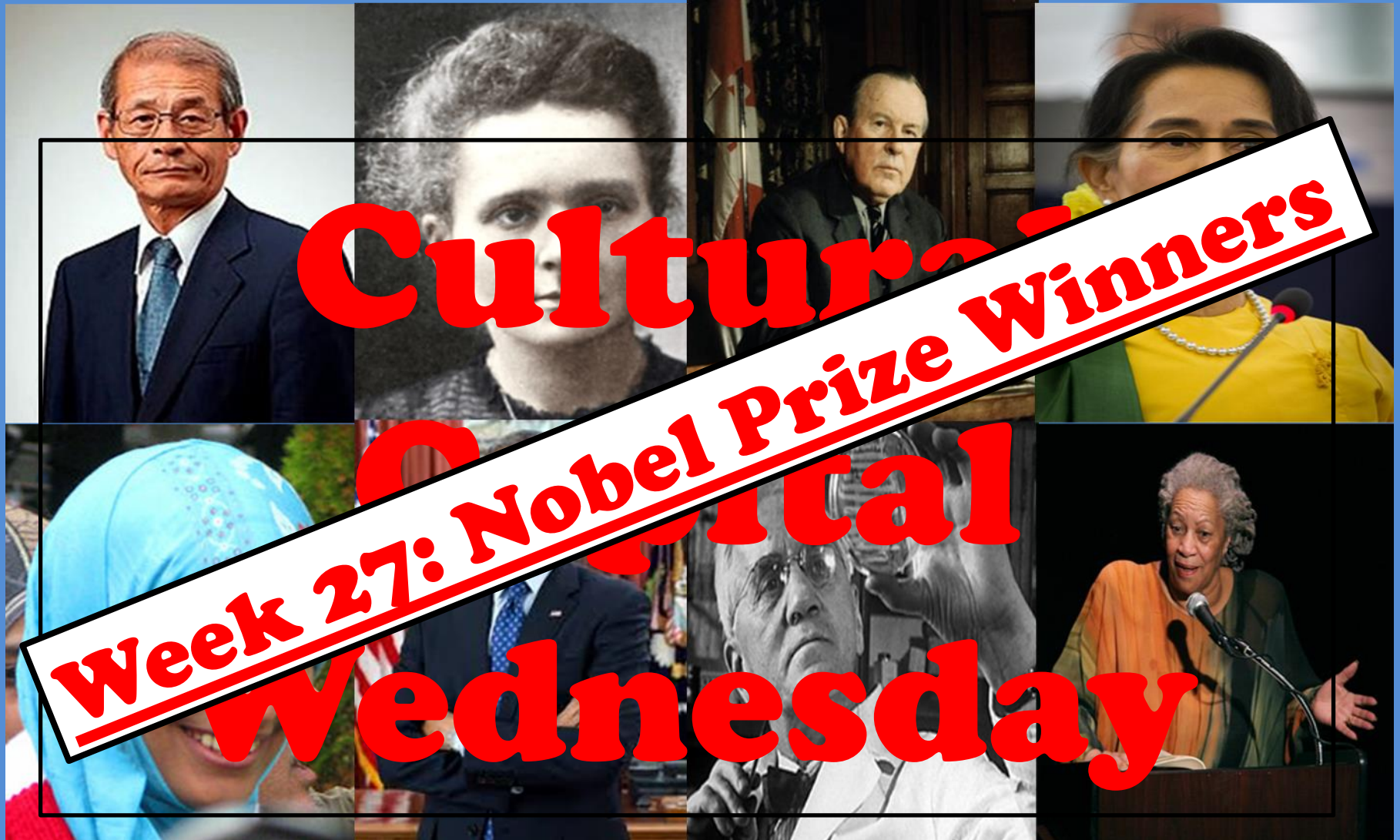

The Nobel Prize is a set of annual international awards given in several categories by in recognition of people who have made advances in chemistry, physics, peace, medicine, the economy, and literature. It was the will of the Swedish chemist, engineer and industrialist Alfred Nobel established the Nobel prizes in 1895.

Nobel Prize winners

1.

Akira Yoshino

Akira Yoshino is a Japanese chemist who won the **Nobel Prize for Chemistry**. The prize was awarded to him in **2019** for his invention, the first safe rechargeable battery (now used in phones and laptops).

2.

Marie Curie

Marie Curie is a Polish scientific who won the **Nobel Prize for Physics**. The prize was awarded to her in **1903** for her research in radiation. She was also the first woman to win the Nobel Prize.

3.

Lester B. Pearson

Lester B. Pearson was a former Canadian Prime Minister who won the **Nobel Prize for Peace**. The prize was awarded to him in **1957** for his involvement in resolving the Suez Canal crisis in Egypt.

4.

Aung San Suu Kyi

Aung Sun Suu Kyi is a political leader and activist who won the **Nobel prize for Peace**. The prize was awarded to her in **1991** for fight to bring democracy and human rights to Myanmar.

5.

Tawakkol Karman

Tawakkol Karman is a Yemeni journalist, politician, and human rights activist who won the **Nobel Prize for Peace**. The prize was awarded to her in **2011** for her role in Yemen uprising in **2011** (during the Arab Spring).

6.

Barack Obama

Barack Obama is Former **U.S. President** who won the **Nobel Prize for Peace**. The prize was awarded to him in **2009** for work his on the reducing of nuclear weapon development around the world.

7.

Alexander Fleming

Alexander Fleming is a Scottish biologist who won the **Nobel Prize for Medicine**. The prize was awarded to him in **1945** for his discovery of penicillin, a medication that helps with infections.

8.

Toni Morrison

Toni Morrison is a American Author who won the **Nobel Prize for Literature**. The prize was awarded to her in **1993** for novel trilogy Beloved that depicted African American lives.
