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UNIT OVERVIEW: Theme E – Taking Action

ENQUIRY: How do you take citizenship action to promote change or benefit others?

Unit intention: Students will take citizenship action of their choosing, agreed by their teacher, to either benefit the wider community or to seek change/promote a cause. Taking action is the best way to democratically participate and demonstrate a number of key skills, including advocacy, lobbying, negotiation, decision making, leadership and teamwork. This unit will truly empower students to be citizens and give them the opportunity to make a difference, either locally, nationally or globally.
