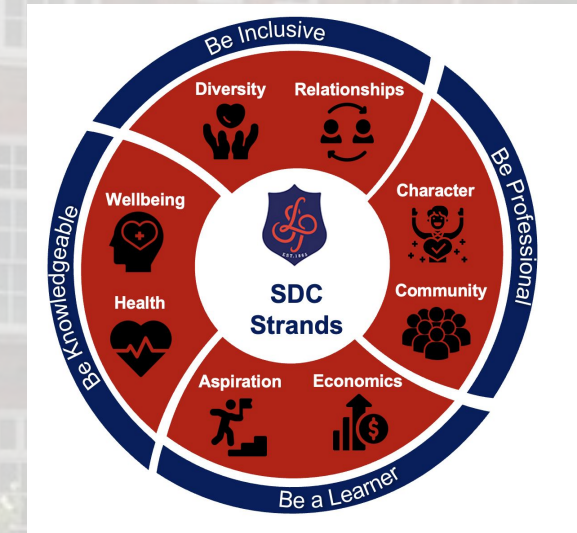

Sustainable Tech Futures

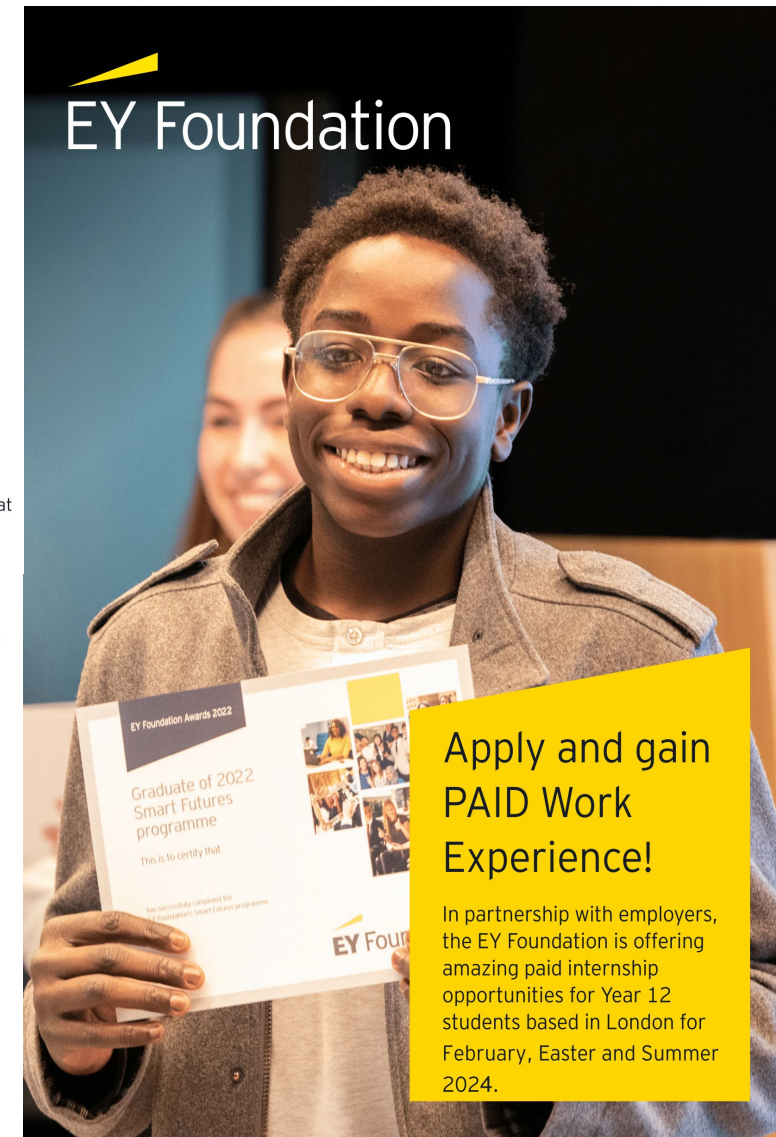
This specialist programme, focuses on sustainability within **tech careers**.

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Changes to Y13 AtL's



Currently you receive a AtL score by your subject teacher between 4 to 1, 4 being outstanding and 1 being poor. We will continue to use these scores however, on your report there will be an additional 'comment' column with a code ranging from A* to A1-A4 or B* to B1-B4. Each code will represent an area that your subject teacher feels you excel in or an area your teacher feels requires further development. Through this process you will be able to focus on the area your teacher suggested to ensure that you are making the right level of progress.

The following side will provide you with additional information regarding these codes.

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What do these codes mean



Code s	Comments (3-4)	Codes	Comments (1-2)	Linked to...
A1	Punctual, ready and willing to learn with correct equipment and work is presented at a good standard.	B1	A student who is sometimes unprepared for lesson. Student sometimes behaves inappropriately causing disruption to learning.	Organisation
A2	Polite and respectful to staff and peers. Consistently upholds 4Bs.	B2	Often late to lessons without all the necessary equipments needed for learning. Work is not presented at a good standard and requires several reminders throughout the lesson to ensure that they remain focussed throughout the lesson.	Behaviour
A3	Committed and determined to achieve – always on task and working with high effort.	B3	Often lacking the motivation to achieve their best. Often the work is completed at an unsatisfactory level.	Effort
A4	Consistently completing homework on time and to the best of their ability.	B4	Often H/W is not completed or standards are below their expected level of ability.	Homework
A*	Student upholds all values celebrated at LPS. Students encompasses A1-A4.	B*	Student fails to uphold any of the values celebrated at LPS, B1-B4.	

If you have received and Atl score of 3 you will receive a code between A1-A4 highlighting an area, you excel in.

If you have received and Atl score of 4 – you will receive an A* which indicates that you are upholding all the values expected by a LPS student.

AtL score of 2, you will receive a code between B1-B4, highlighting an area you will need to focus on.

AtL score of 1=B*. Indicating that you have yet to uphold any values expected by a student at LPS.

This Matrix will be printed on your reports for you and your family to refer to.

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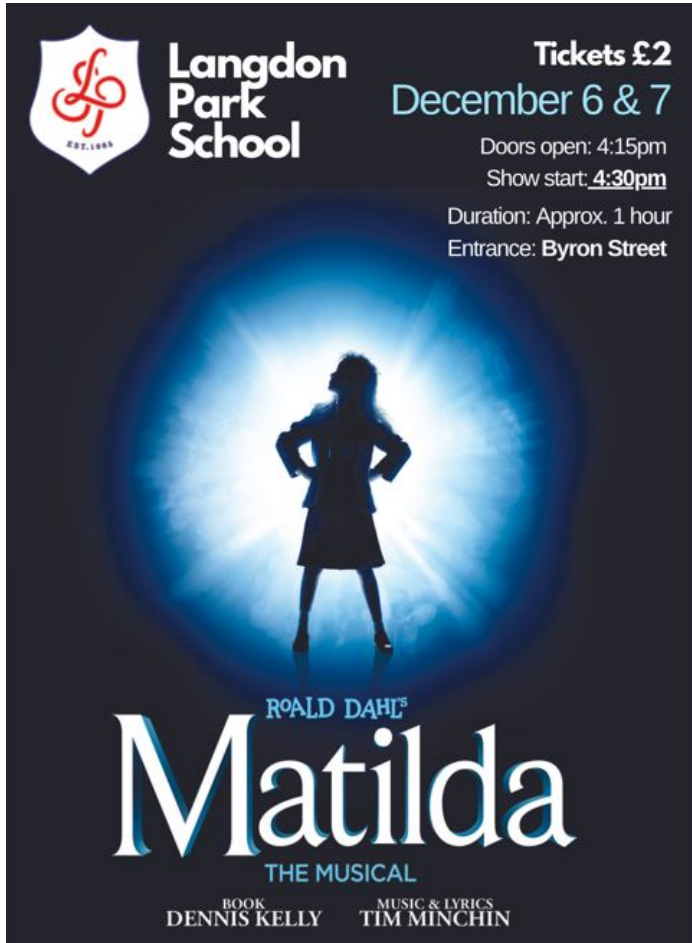

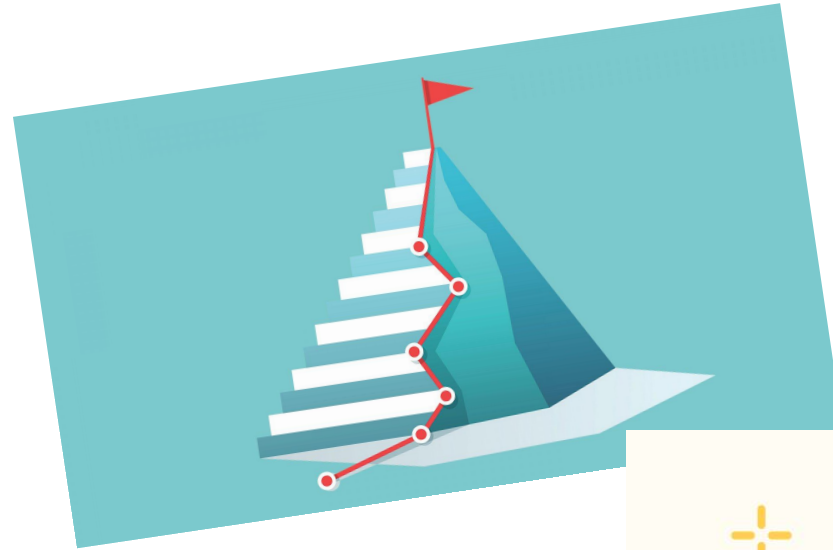
