
## **Anti- Bullying Campaign**

Think, pair, share: What social media platform is this? How does it work? How is it different to other platforms?




## **Anti- Bullying Campaign**



#### **Snapchat:**

Snapchat is a mobile app that allows users to capture videos/images and send messages that disappear after a few seconds. It also has a very specific screenshot policy, which means users will be notified if you have taken a screencap of their posts. This allows for better privacy and unfiltered sharing.

Whilst this can be a fun and appealing way to communicate with your friends and loved ones, some people take this as an opportunity to spread rumours, gossip and hateful messages. They feel it's easier to do so because it can be easily 'erased' and harder to trace.



Although the Snaps disappear without a trace, their messages can leave lasting impacts. It is important to think about what you send, before sending it. Ask yourself, is this hurtful? Would I be okay with a trusted adult seeing me send this? If the answer is no, do not send!



## **Anti- Bullying Campaign**



#### Snapchat's Guide to Blocking

Two ways to block unwanted contact

#### From the name:

- 1. Swipe right to go to the Chat screen
- 2. Tap and hold on a friend's name
- 3. Tap 'More'
- 4. Tap 'Block'

#### From the profile:

- 1. Swipe right to go to the Chat screen
- 2. Tap on a Chat with that friend
- 3. Tap their profile icon at the top
- 4. Tap the at the top
- 5. Tap 'Block'

If you see a hurtful message on snapchat, it is important to report the account, user or post.

Additionally, screenshot the post where possible to evidence and show a trusted adult.

Do not forward the screenshots to friends as it can increase the level of rumour and gossip.
