Examples of other literacy interventions we use are Ruth Miskin. ● To promote reading for pleasure ● Encourage reluctant readers as well as promoting independent reading.

2020/2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Y7s & Y8s were assessed using the NGRT assessment ● Y7s on the Catch-up list were automatically considered for the intervention- however, the length and type depended on the NGRT scores. 34 students fell into this category. Of this number, 5 of them were in the Transition Group ● In addition to the catch-up list, 31 students scored below reading age of 9:00 years old. In total we had 52 students ● 5 are getting EAL support. ● 5 Students got reading age 10 years old therefore were given in class support. ● ● Students were put in groups of 4-6 where they received 2x50mins sessions per week for 12 weeks ● During lockdown intervention specialist set work from Kerboodle Literacy via google classroom 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Individual progress can be extracted from MyOn ● Activities/quizzes could be completed at home as quizzes <p>Outcomes</p> <p>All catch-up students have made progress except for 6 students. This was due to lack of engagement to GC and lessons were set to be face-to-face but no one turned up. Parents were highly anxious of sending their kids. These students continue with a different intervention.</p> <p>TG Students are still getting small groups literacy with a SEND teacher support and teaching.</p> <p>Students with reading age 9 years old and below have made significant progress and are back in their main stream lessons and are monitored by TAs in their lessons.</p> <p><i>Lessons learnt: Provide a working space for students in school during break, lunch and after school.</i></p> <p><i># An ICT room where students could access quizzes</i></p>
