

KS3 Progress Descriptors

Year 7 and Year 8:

Year 7 and Year 8 students will receive a score from 4-1 indicating the standard of work they are currently producing in each subject. Below is a description of each score and what it means:

- 4 = Exceeding standards for their prior attainment group (on track to <u>exceed</u> their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)
- 3 = Meeting standards for their prior attainment group (on track to <u>reach</u> their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)
- 2 = Below standards for their prior attainment group (<u>not on track to reach</u> their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)
- 1 = Far below standards for their prior attainment group (<u>significantly below</u> being on track to reach their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)

Year 9:

Year 9 students will receive a score from 4-1 indicating the GCSE grade range they are currently work at. This is a teacher assessed actual GCSE grade range based upon their current performance in class:

4 = Grade 7+

3 = Grade 5-6

2 = Grade 3-4

1 = Grade 1-2
