## KS3 Progress Descriptors

## Year 7 and Year 8:

Year 7 and Year 8 students will receive a score from 4-1 indicating the standard of work they are currently producing in each subject. Below is a description of each score and what it means:

4 = Exceeding standards for their prior attainment group (on track to exceed their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)

3 = Meeting standards for their prior attainment group (on track to reach their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)

2 = Below standards for their prior attainment group (not on track to reach their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)

1 = Far below standards for their prior attainment group (significantly below being on track to reach their target grade in their Year 11 GCSE)

## Year 9:

Year 9 students will receive a score from 4-1 indicating the GCSE grade range they are currently work at. This is a teacher assessed actual GCSE grade range based upon their current performance in class:

4 = Grade 7+
3 = Grade 5-6
2 = Grade 3-4
1 = Grade 1-2
