# **Procedures and Routines**



At the start of each PE lesson, students need to line up on the pitch by the PE classroom where your teacher will meet you and lead you to get changed.



Students are to get changed sensibly and quietly once inside the changing rooms. We want all students to be changed and ready to learn in less than **10 minutes**.





Once the register has been taken by your class teacher in the changing rooms, you will be asked to wait in your learning area ready to start the lesson.



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## PE Kit Must Haves!

Students MUST wear the LPS PE top.

Students MUST wear the LPS tracksuit bottoms <u>or</u> plain navy/black short.

Students should wear appropriate footwear for sports. E.g. Running Trainers



Students still MUST wear the LPS PE top. Under Armour/skins can be worn to cover arms and legs but must be navy/black in colour.

When students take part in dance they are allowed to wear leggings.

Dance lessons will require you to remove your shoes and socks



Note: Girls can wear a hijab in PE as long as it is tied tight to their head and has no pins in or isn't loose and hanging down. This is for health and safety reasons.



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Note: If you lose an item of your PE Kit you MUST bring a spare kit accompanied with a note from home. If you are injured or exempt from PE you MUST still bring your PE kit in accompanied with a note.
